Staff Induction Training

All staff receive induction training to help them understand their roles and responsibilities. The training includes;

- Safeguarding
- Child Protection
- Health and Safety
- Emergency Evacuation Procedures
- Equality Policy
- Mission Statement

Supervision of Staff

All staff will be supervised by their line manager at least once per term. Supervision is provided to support teamwork, identify solutions to address issues as they arise and to coach to improve individual effectiveness.

Paediatric First Aiders

At least one person with a current paediatric First Aid certificate will be on the premises at all times when children are present. Refresher training will be available to all staff when certificates expire.

Key Person

Each child will be given a key person to ensure that every child's care is tailored to meet their individual needs. The key worker will help each child become familiar with the setting and build a settled relationship with each child and parent or carer.



Staff: Child Ratios

For children aged under two:

- there is one member of staff for every three children; and one member of staff holds a full and relevant level 3 qualification, and is experienced in working with children under two;
- at least half of all other staff hold at least a full and relevant level 2 qualification;
- at least half of all staff must have received training that specifically addresses the care of babies; and
- where there is an under two-year-olds room, the member of staff in charge of that room must, in the judgement of the provider, have suitable experience of working with under twos.

For children aged two and above

- there is be at least one member of staff for every four children;
- at least one member of staff holds a full and relevant level 3 qualification; and
- at least half of all other staff hold a full and relevant level 2 qualification

For children aged three and over

- there is be at least one member of staff for every eight children;
- at least one member of staff holds a full and relevant level 3 qualification; and
- at least half of all other staff hold a full and relevant level 2 qualification.
