


	Title: Holey Moley Author: Bethan Clarke Keywords: Animals, rhymes, humour	When Gus Goat meets Mavis Mole, he tries to guess where she lives. Is it in a hole? In a bowl!? In a sausage roll!!! Perfect for inspiring a love of language in little ones.
	Title: The Bear Behind Author: Sam Copeland Keywords: Humour, schools, emotions	Meet Ivor, a little boy in a big world, who absolutely, categorically, definitely does NOT like any sort of attention. So it's more than a minor catastrophe for Ivor to discover on his first day of school that he has a great BIG bear behind!
