Key Responsibilities:

A. SEN Teaching at Wyvern House

- Teach pupils 1:1, in pairs, or in small groups across a broad curriculum.
- Deliver engaging, differentiated Maths lessons to pupils with a wide range of additional needs.
- Maintain calm, positive classroom environments tailored to individual EHCPs.
- Work closely with parents, SENCo, and support staff to develop and review Individual Teaching Plans (ITPs).
- Attend and contribute to EHCP annual reviews and maintain accurate pupil records.
- Monitor and report on progress through formative and summative assessment.
- Make effective use of ICT and multisensory teaching strategies.
- Participate in break/lunch duties and contribute to the broader life of Wyvern House.

B. Teaching Maths in the Senior School (KS3 & KS4)

- Teach Maths to KS3 and KS4 pupils up to GCSE level following departmental schemes of work.
- Prepare pupils for internal assessments and public exams, including coursework and revision support.
- Mark and assess student work according to school policy, maintaining detailed records.
- Differentiate lessons appropriately for pupils with SEND and those who are more able.
- Communicate progress to parents through reports and parents' evenings.
- Stay up to date with developments in Maths education and continually review teaching methods.

Wider Responsibilities

- Contribute to staff meetings, in-service training, and school-wide events as required.
 - Support the House system and participate in school duties (break/lunch/cover).
 - Engage in the school's performance management and CPD programme.
 - Organise the presentation and display of pupils' work.
 - Undertake any reasonable task as directed by the SMT or Manager of Wyvern House.
